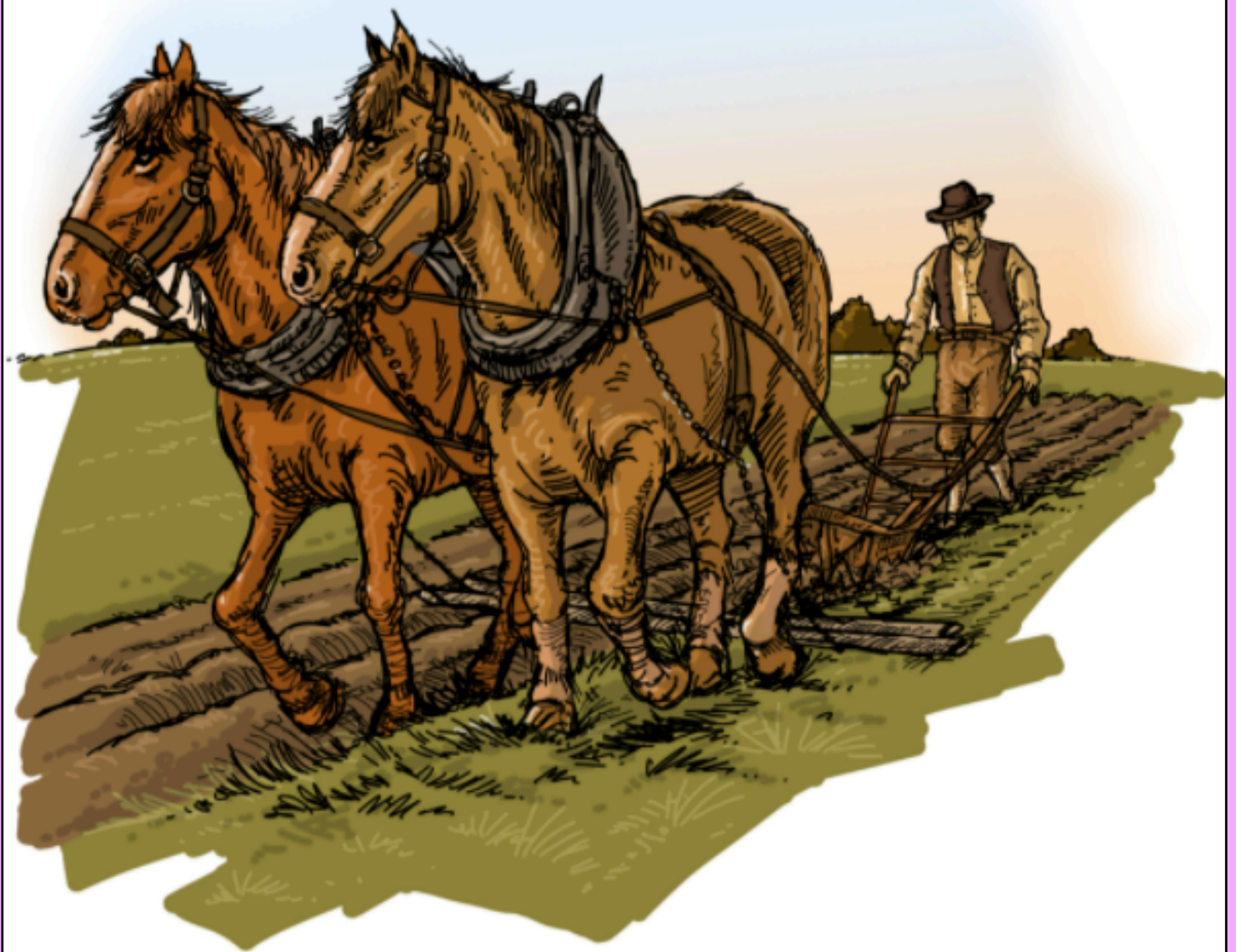

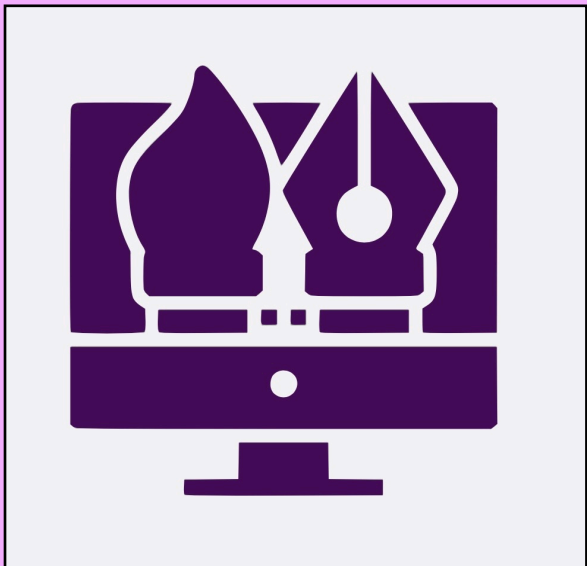

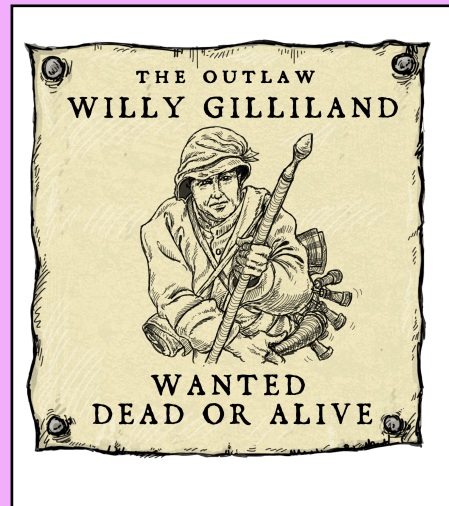

The aim is to research the different aspects of Ulster-Scots history explored in Module 2 with a view to designing new iconic images that will convey the essential features of the Ulster Scot.



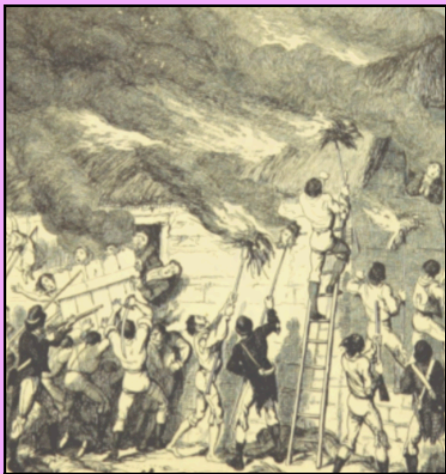
